Tilia Malbec 2007 - 87 POINTS

My favorite of the Tilia wines is the purple-colored 2007 Malbec. The nose reveals plenty of black cherry and black raspberry fruit, medium body and a bit of structure.

Tilia Chardonnay 2007 - 86 POINTS

The medium-straw colored 2007 Chardonnay offers a surprisingly complex bouquet of spring flowers, apple, pear and tropical fruits. Made in a straightforward style with ripe, tasty flavors. Excellent Value.

Tilia Malbec-Syrah 2007 - 86 POINTS

The 2007 Malbec-Syrah is also purple-colored with an attractive nose of black cherry and blueberry. It has a good core of fruit, a supple texture and no hard edges.

Tilia Merlot 2007 - 86 POINTS

Dark ruby-colored, it reveals spicy red fruit aromas and flavors, purity and excellent depth.
